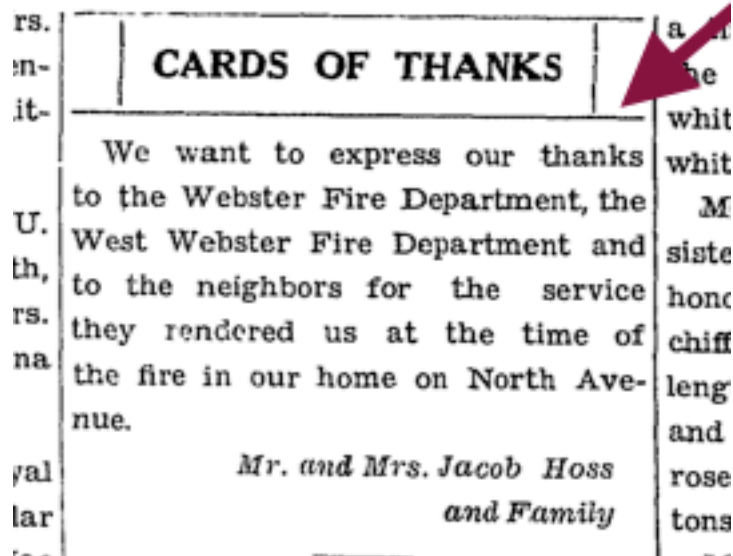


# Hoss House Burns
